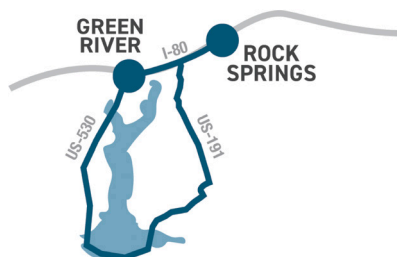

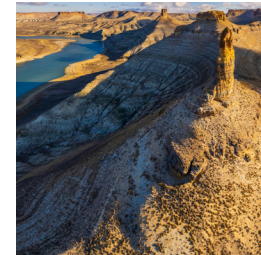
THE EXPERIENCE
